OUR SERVICES

- **Digital mammography**
Digital mammography is essentially the same as the x-ray film system, however, the film has been replaced by solid-state detectors that convert x-rays into electrical signals. The electrical signals are used to produce images of the breast that can be seen on a computer screen.
- **Needle localization procedures**
Needle localization procedures is an x-ray procedure that uses multiple coordinates to determine the location of calcifications or a nodule so that the surgeon can remove the area in question.
- **Ultrasound**
Ultrasound imaging involves using high-frequency sound waves to produce a picture of the internal structures of the breast.

OUR TECHNOLOGY

The Center for Women's Imaging uses the Selenia™ digital mammography system from Hologic®, a leading developer of state-of-the-art digital imaging technology for general radiography and mammography applications. Selenia™ has the largest detector size in the industry and improved imaging on patients under 50 with fibrocystic breast tissue. Our mammography system offers:

- **Three dimensional breast imaging**
reduces and eliminates the tissue overlap effect of traditional mammography
- **Improved diagnostic sensitivity**
for the early detection of breast cancer
- **Computer-Aided Detection (CAD)**
highlights abnormalities associated with breast cancer and flags them for Radiologists, effectively acting as a second set of eyes
